#### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO LEASE LAND AND CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Gannawarra Shire Council (Council) gives notice under Section 190 of the *Local Government Act 1989* (the Act), that it intends to Lease part of the land described below (Proposal). The land is known as 12 View Street, Koondrook being the whole of the land comprised in certificate of Title Volume 11450 Folio 161 and shown hatched on the plan below (the Land).



The **Proposal** is that the **Land** be leased by private treaty to Optus Mobile Pty Limited (the **Prospective Tenant**). The principal terms of the lease will be:

- The permitted use of part of the Land will be for telecommunications network and services;
- An initial lease term of 2 years together with a further lease term of 15 years, giving a combined possible lease period of 17 years;
- Commencing Annual rent of \$8,900 (plus GST) and increased by 2% on an annual basis, and
- otherwise on contractual terms satisfactory to Council.

Any submissions in relation to the proposed lease will be considered in accordance with Section 223 of the **Act**, which provides that:-

- a) Any submissions in respect of this matter received by Council no later than Monday 23 January 2017 will be considered;
- b) Any person who has made a submission to Council is entitled to request to appear in person or to be represented by a person specified in the submission at a meeting to be heard in support of the submission.

Submitters should be aware that submissions are required to be available for public inspection.

Submissions should be addressed to the CEO, and can be hand delivered to Council's Municipal Office at Patchell Plaza, 47 Victoria Street, Kerang or posted to Eric Braslis, CEO, Gannawarra Shire Council, PO Box 287, Kerang VIC 3579.
