## KERANG TRUCK WASH PRICING

Council took over the management of the Kerang Saleyards truck wash on 1 April 2019.

Users of the truck wash will be charged a rate of \$0.59 per minute (excluding GST), with the minimum charge being \$3.00 (excluding GST).

The truck wash can be accessed 24/7, and those wanting to use the truck wash who do not have a token should contact Council – either by visiting the Kerang Customer Service Centre or phoning (03) 5450 9333 – to purchase a token. Tokens cost \$30 and enable users to operate the truck wash, both in Kerang and at any AvData facility across Australia.

## WANDERING LIVESTOCK

Council is urging livestock owners to ensure their animals are well secured.

The number of stray livestock callouts Council Local Laws officers have attended so far this year has increased compared to previous years, with three collisions involving motor vehicles or trains occurring.

Stock owners and keepers have legal obligations to ensure their livestock do not stray onto highways or roads.

It is an offence to keep livestock on any property which is not securely fenced.

Stock owners can be fined up to \$8050 for allowing livestock to escape onto public roads.

I would also like to encourage those visiting the Gannawarra this Easter long weekend to experience the area's lakes, rivers and forests.

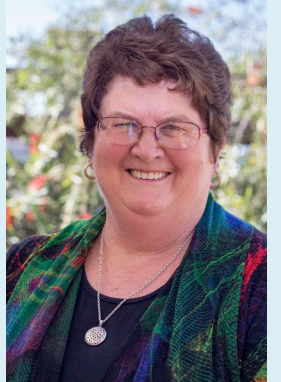

## WASTE SKIPS AVAILABLE FOR DISPOSAL OF CAMPERS' RUBBISH

Visitors camping in the Gannawarra this Easter are encouraged to use increased waste bin facilities that will be located at numerous locations throughout the Shire.

Skip bins will be placed at seven locations throughout the Shire to cater for rubbish that campers and visitors to the Shire's major natural attractions will accumulate during the Easter long weekend.

Council has provided this service to visitors since 2010, ensuring large volumes of rubbish is disposed of correctly rather than left within the Shire's forests.

Residents are reminded that these skips are not to be used for general waste or items that can be taken to one of Council's Transfer Stations for disposal.
