Tactics for Tough Times Program

The T4TT program works with farmers and the wider community to support and build resilience.

The program is being implemented by Northern District Community Health across the four shires of Swan Hill, Gannawarra, Buloke and Loddon.

The Program Coordinator will work with businesses, service providers and community members.

A skilled Mental Health Nurse who can sit at the kitchen table with farmers and provide counselling is also part of the T4TT program.
