SCORESBY STREET PROGRESS

Work to upgrade the next section of streetscape in the Kerang CBD has commenced, after the first section at the Victoria St/Scoresby St intersection, outside of the McKnight & Bray building, was completed earlier last week.

Works have moved across the road to the corner of Scoresby and Victoria Street intersection, in front of Kerang Optical, and are expected to take 2-3 weeks.
