
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SELL COUNCIL PROPERTY

More than 5.8 million Australians and 11,633 health care providers are now registered for My Health Record.

What is My Health Record?

My Health Record is an online summary of your health information. You control what goes into your record, and who can access it. Share your health information with doctors, hospitals and other healthcare providers from anywhere, any time.

The Australian Government has announced that every Australian will be offered a My Health Record unless they choose not to have one during the three month opt-out period, from July 16 to October 15, 2018. For more information visit www.myhealthrecord.gov.au

This week we celebrate NAIDOC Week with the theme of 'Because of her we can.' We have some inspiring female aboriginal leaders in our community who were celebrated yesterday at a community celebration in Kerang.

Last month the Koondrook Wharf designed by architect TERROIR took out all 3 awards it was nominated for in the 2018 Victoria Architecture Awards - the Regional Prize Architecture Award, Urban Design Architecture Award and Small Projects Architecture Award.

This is a huge recognition for architect TERROIR, as well as Council and the community who worked together on the project! The Koondrook Wharf will now progress to the National Architecture Awards and in addition has been nominated for the World Architectural Festival Awards in Amsterdam. What an achievement!

We have some exciting projects coming up in the future including the Koondrook Nature Based Tourism Hub, Cohuna to Koondrook Forest Trail, and the Kerang Lakes, Cohuna and Koondrook Waterfront Masterplans.

The DRAFT Background and Concept Plan Discussion paper

for the waterfronts has been received and is currently in the process of being reviewed against the consultation information. This document will then feed into the Masterplan. The Masterplan document will help inform Council's Capital Works Program with a wide range of potential projects identified. It is important to have this level of project planning documentation so projects can align with regional priorities when applying for funding.

The Cohuna to Koondrook Forest Trail is part of the Murray River Adventure Trail, a high priority cross border project that will span the length of the Murray River. The proposal will provide accommodation connections to places such as Cohuna and Koondrook while supporting a range of new tourism and hospitality businesses linked to nature based tourism.

I look forward to seeing what we can continue to achieve together as a community.

NATURE BASED TOURISM HUB

Tenders have been awarded for the construction of glamping tents and a footbridge as part of the Nature Based Tourism Hub project at Koondrook. The tender of the footbridge was awarded to Maritime Constructions and will be designed by architect TERROIR using the same style and materials as the Koondrook Wharf.

Six safari style glamping tents will be the centre piece of the tourism hub with a combination of layouts catering for 2 to 4 people and will be constructed by GlamXperience. Each of the tents will feature an ensuite, kitchenette, dishwasher, split system heating and cooling. Each tent will also have a private deck with views of the Gunbower Creek.

Council anticipates that construction will commence later this year with completion early to mid-2019.



SOCIAL INCLUSION SURVEY

Council is asking members of the community to provide their thoughts regarding social inclusion.

An inclusive community is one where people feel valued and involved, can take part in social events, sporting and cultural activities, and have the opportunity to work or volunteer.

Council is asking people to provide their thoughts via a short survey, which (among other questions) asks about people's experiences when it comes to being included in their local community, their views on community acceptance and what could help improve inclusion.

This includes people most at risk of social exclusion – people with disability, LGBTIQ community members, culturally and linguistically diverse residents, Indigenous community members, younger and older residents and those experiencing socio-economic disadvantage. Feedback from the surveys will help Council develop a Social Inclusion Strategy and will only take 5 to 10 minutes to complete. Your feedback is anonymous and can be completed online via Council's website.

Hard copies are also available from the Shire offices in Kerang and Cohuna as well as the Kerang, Cohuna and Leitchville libraries, and Quambatook Community Resource Centre.
