Residents are encouraged to have their say on Council's 2022/2023 Proposed Budget by 5pm Monday, 6 June. Features of the 2022/2023 Proposed Budget include a \$13.229 million capital works program which focuses on town developments, investment in recreational facility improvements and supporting tourism initiatives, and compliance with the State Government's Fair Go Rates System, which states that the total revenue raised through municipal rates cannot increase by more than 1.75 per cent compared to the previous year.
