AMENDMENTS TO INCORPORATED DOCUMENTS IN SCHEDULE 2 - LOCAL LAW NO.1 COMMUNITY **AMENITY 2012**

Public Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of Gannawarra Shire Council held on 20 November 2013, Council adopted Roadsides, Parks and Reserves Trading Policy 123. The new policy includes the declaration of roadside, parks and reserves trading under Clause 52 of Local Law No.1 Community Amenity 2012. Council has incorporated the new policy in the Schedule of Local Law No.1 Community Amenity 2012 as

Schedule 2 Policies and Other Incorporated Documents now includes an incorporated copy of Council's Roadsides, Parks and Reserves Trading Policy 123, as amended from time to time.

The purpose of the policy is to specify Council's requirements and expectations relating to authorisation of the use of public footpaths, roadside, parks or reserve areas for the purpose of operating an itinerant business and to ensure that such activities do not adversely impact on local residents or business operators.

The general purport of the incorporated policy includes fee structure, duration of permit, hours of operation, risk assessment and insurance, compliance and approval.

I would like to see more young people involved in the community & working together to make a caring & supportive environment for all


