DECLARATION OF BOATING ACTIVITY EXEMPTION

For the purpose of boating activity by Ski Racing Victoria, masters of vessels involved in the Point Score 5 event are exempt from the waterway rules as they apply to the waters established as an activity exclusion zone on the waters of Lake Charm.
