It's not too late to protect late plantings of tomatoes, capsicums, eggplants and any remaining fruit crops from Queensland fruit fly (QFF) before they ripen. Controlling QFF in your backyard not only protects your produce, it also reduces fly numbers in our towns and supports statewide efforts to control this pest. CALICIVIRUS RELEASE SET TO OCCUR AT KERANG

Gannawarra Shire Council advises that it will be conducting a release of the Calicivirus (RHDV1 K5) adjacent to the Kerang Township from Thursday February 8, 2018. This is the same strain of Calicivirus that was released early in 2017 as part of a nation-wide effort to control wild rabbit populations. While the virus is already in the area, residents with pet rabbits are reminded to check that their pet rabbits are vaccinated. Further releases are planned at several other sites throughout the shire in the coming weeks. Please contact your local vet for more information on vaccinating your pet rabbit.
