In accordance with section 125 of the Local Government Act 1989 (the Act), at least once in each financial year Council considers whether its current Council Plan requires any adjustment in respect of the remaining period of the Plan. At its meeting on 16 May 2018, Council resolved to endorse the 'Council Plan 2017 - 2021 - Proposed Councillor Adjustments' and invite people to make submissions. Written submissions about the 'Council Plan 2017 - 2021 -Proposed Councillor Adjustments' will be considered in accordance with section 223 of the Act and should be addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Gannawarra Shire Council, PO Box 287, Kerang Vic 3579.
