I would like to start off by thanking the community for their input into the Draft Council Plan and Proposed 2017/18 Budget. Council staff have worked hard to ensure thorough consultation has been done to best inform you all of what these documents mean to you as a community. We have been provided with some great feedback from the community which will help us move forward.

This week we are celebrating Reconciliation Week with community events being held on Wednesday in Kerang and Friday in Koondrook and Cohuna. I encourage all members of the local community to come along and join in the celebrations. In addition a commemoration to the Stolen Generation has been named as a finalist in the prestigious 2017 Community HART awards, the winners will be presented at an event in Melbourne on Friday that I will be attending, keep an eye out on Council's Facebook page to see if we are successful. Regardless, it is a wonderful achievement to be shortlisted. It was great to see many schools participating in National Walk Safely to School Day, especially with the implementation of *Stop, Look, Listen, Think* pedestrian safety messages on the footpath near Kerang South Primary School. Council intends to implement these pedestrian safety messages to schools across the Shire in the lead up to the Walk to School program in October.

I have had a busy couple of weeks attending some important meetings, including with the Mallee Regional Partnership in Charlton, where some great discussion was held around priorities for the region and I strongly encourage the community to register to attend the next Regional Assembly in Swan Hill. All the details can be found at engage.vic.gov.au/mallee. At the MAV State Council Gannawarra proposed 3 motions and all were successful. The most important one was about valuations going yearly instead of bi-annually and for this to be successful is great for the region.

Lastly I attended a Mental Health Foundation multicultural dinner in May, which was to promote awareness of mental health throughout all religions and cultures. This is something that I see as a personal goal, to ensure all people have the same availability to mental health facilities.
