VEGETATION MANAGEMENT NEAR OVERHEAD POWERLINES

Gannawarra Shire Council will carry out Vegetation Powerline Clearance works in Kerang.

As part of this program the Street Trees and Powerlines are inspected regularly to ensure no impact to power supply through conflict with trees.

Vegetation maintenance works is required to be carried out in compliance with the Electricity Safety (Electric Line Clearance) Regulation 2015. These Regulations stipulate a minimum safe clearance between tree and Powerlines, to keep re-growth clear of Powerlines.

Gannawarra Shire Council is responsible for the Powerline clearance of trees on Council land in the area highlighted on the map below.

Please note: The tree works in this area will be carried out over the next 14 to 60 days. Regular auditing occurs throughout the year.
