ANIMAL REGISTRATION RENEWALS DISTRIBUTED

Council has extended the deadline for cat and dog owners to pay their annual animal registration renewals, with payment now due by 5pm Monday, 8 May.

As outlined in the *Domestic Animals Act* 1994, all dogs and cats over three months of age must be registered with their local Council and microchipped.

Reduced registration fees are applicable for pets aged over 10 years; dogs kept for working stock; animals that are registered with an Applicable Organisation; and animals that are desexed.

Payment can be made in person at Council's Customer Service Centres, by cheque or money order mailed to Council, over the phone by phoning (03) 5450 9333 or online via BPAY. A separate BPAY payment is required per animal. If you have any questions regarding your registration, please phone Council on (03) 5450 9333.
