A late payment fee of \$38.00 per animal may apply to payments made after 11 April 2019.



## **CANCER SURVIVOR SUPPORT GROUP**

Murray Primary Health Network (PHN) is establishing a cancer support group within the Gannawarra Shire to provide a safe space for people affected by cancer. Developed through a partnership between Murray PHN, Gannawarra Shire Council, Buloke Shire Council, Kerang District Health, East Wimmera Health and Mallee District Aboriginal Services, a "meet and greet" event to form the group will be held in May.
