SWANSONG - A STORY OF GRIT, TERROR AND HEARTACHE

If you expect intensity or blatant confrontation from a solo show, Swansong – being held on Saturday, 25 May from 7.30pm at the Cohuna Memorial Hall - will not disappoint. Set in the 1960s, Swansong tells the story of Austin 'Occi' Byrne (Andre De Vanny), the illegitimate child of a single mother in the Catholic west of Ireland.

Shunned by church, State and family, Occi and his beloved Mammy are ostracised.

After childhood bullying leaves him with mild brain damage, Occi struggles to control his increasingly violent impulses as Mammy spirals ever further with alcohol abuse.

It's an exhilarating journey that plunges him in to murder and mayhem, love and death, only to return him to the place he
