# **COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM CLOSING SOON!**

Community groups and organisations are reminded that they have a few weeks left to apply under Council's 2018 Community Grants program.

Grants are available to support both community projects as well as a separate category that seeks to stimulate new events or grow existing community events.

Grant applications can be submitted through an online system under the following categories:

#### **1. Community Support Grant**

(for funding up to \$5000 per application)

2. Events Grant (with three types available)

- Community Events (up to \$500 per application)
- Minor Events (up to \$2000 per application)
- Major Events (up to \$5000 per application)

The Community Grants Program is designed to complement the 2017-2021 Council Plan and to help fund community goals for the nine towns and districts located across the Gannawarra Shire.

Applicants are strongly encouraged to contact Council to discuss a project idea before submitting a grant application with applications closing at 5.00pm on Monday September 3, 2018.

## **PICK MY PROJECT - VOTE NOW!**

Community members from across the Gannawarra Shire are encouraged to vote for thirteen local projects as part of the state government's Pick My Project community grants program.

The innovative \$30 million community grants program sought project ideas valued between \$20,000 and \$200,000 from across Victoria.

Assessment of project ideas is now complete with more than 2000 projects progressing to the public vote. Seventeen projects were submitted from across the Gannawarra Shire with thirteen projects selected to proceed to a public vote.

## VICTORIA SQUARE WINS **ARCHITECTURE AWARD!**

Kerang's Victoria Square has won the Award of Excellence in the Urban Design category of the 2018 Victorian Landscape Architecture Awards.

The nomination was submitted by the architect company Hansen Partnership and is a great acknowledgment to Council who managed the project and community members who were involved in the consultation and design.

There are five Cohuna projects, two from Quambatook, and one each from Murrabit, Macorna, Leitchville, Lalbert, Lake Charm and Koondrook included.

Voting will close 5pm, Monday September 17, 2018. Pick My Project is an online voting system with registration required at www.pickmyproject.vic.gov.au.

The Victorian Landscape Architecture Awards recognise highquality strategic and landscape design-led projects that enhance public spaces, engage with the community and exemplify enduring design.

Victoria Square will now proceed to the National Awards to be announced on Thursday October 11, 2018 as part of this year's International Festival of Landscape Architecture.
