## COVID-19 RECOVERY SURVEY

Residents are encouraged to help shape the municipality's social and economic recovery from COVID-19 by completing Council's COVID-19 Community Health, Wellbeing and Recovery Survey.

Two versions have been developed:

- A community version that asks what residents have done differently since social distancing measures were put in place in late March, as well as their views on health and wellbeing during this period; and
- A community group and organisation version that gauges how organisations have operated during the implementation of social distancing measures, as well as challenges that may exist in recommending meetings, activities and events.
