Last week my fellow
Councillors and I made
the difficult decision to
place the Quambatook
Senior Citizens Centre on
the open market for sale.
This once popular building
had been used by the
Quambatook Senior
Citizens Club and other



community groups for many years to host events and celebrations; however, a recent structural condition assessment determined the building is in very poor condition. This is due to widespread severe cracking, movement, and dislodgement of masonry walls, likely due to reactive clay soils and prolonged degradation. This damage would mean returning the building to its former glory would be unjustifiable. Council will discuss the best options available with Quambatook's community groups prior to the hall's sale. Council sought feedback regarding the future of the building and two other Council-owned assets at Quambatook late

Council-owned assets at Quambatook late last year, with a decision on the hall's future and a Council-owned block of units in Guthrie Street, Quambatook following the tragic events that occurred earlier this year.

2025/2026 RATES NOTICES

Council is in the final stages of processing municipal rates notices for 2025/2026. Your municipal rates notice includes what you are required to pay for the Emergency Services and Volunteers Fund (ESVF) levy. Council opposes the introduction of the ESVF in its current form and will take every opportunity to continue to object this on behalf of our community.

If you choose not to pay the ESVF levy, Council is legislated to charge interest and take steps to recover any outstanding amounts. If you only pay a portion of the total amount due, some of the payment will be paid to the State Government to cover the levy.

Council is not permitted to allocate money for rates without also allocating some of the money to the ESVF levy.
