A recent audit of 175 kerbside waste and recycling bins at various locations throughout the Gannawarra found that the contamination rate for recycling bins was 9.4 per cent of the

total weight of materials collected for recycling.

The greatest contributing factor to this contamination rate is the number of instances when recyclables are placed in plastic bags for disposal. These items are actually not recycled, and are instead taken to landfill.
