KOONDROOK ROAD CLOSURE

Main Street, Koondrook will be closed later this month between Keene and Station streets to enable extensive road and stormwater works to occur.

Residents and visitors to Koondrook are advised that the Tramway Place entrance road to the Koondrook boat ramp will be closed due to the works. Those wanting to access the ramp will need to travel via Keene Street and Gunbower Parade, adjacent to the Koondrook Caravan Park. Arbuthnot Street will remain open during the works, with both Apex Park and the Koondrook Wharf unaffected. The works are part of the Koondrook CBD upgrade, which is being made possible thanks to funding from the Regional Roads Victoria Fixing Country Roads program. It is anticipated the road will reopen to the public in May 2019.
