MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Last month Council confirmed its opposition to the compulsory access to, and compulsory acquisition of private land associated with the construction of VNI West. As part of Council's position, we have requested an urgent meeting with the Minister for Climate Action, Energy and Resources to discuss our stance, as well as our communities' concerns. These include consultation with landowners, compensation to impacted residents, and the project's benefits to the Gannawarra Shire. This project will change the Gannawarra's landscape, and it is important that Council seeks appropriate outcomes for all residents, especially those whose land will be impacted by the construction of these transmission lines.

By publicly outlining our stance, my fellow Councillors and I aim to reengage with the Minister to discuss our concerns and get the best outcomes for the Gannawarra. We look forward to providing an update regarding the outcome of these discussions.
