ANIMAL REGISTRATION DUE

Pet owners are reminded that animal registration payments are due by 10 April, 2019.

Animal registration is required under the *Domestic Animals Act 1994* and all dogs and cats over three months of age must be registered with Council and microchipped.

Animal owners can receive a discount if they currently hold an eligible pension card, or if their pet is aged over 10 years, a working dog, registered with an applicable organisation or

Those who have paid their animal registration in the past few days and believe they are entitled to a pension card discount are encouraged to visit either the Cohuna or Kerang Customer Service Centre with their proof of payment and a pension card so that a refund can be processed.

Residents have the option to pay online via BPAY or contact Council to pay over the phone. Alternatively, payment can be made in person at Council's Customer Service Centres. A separate BPAY payment is required per animal.

Payment of an amount different to that shown on the notice must be paid in person at Council's Customer Service

Animal owners wishing to register their pet with Gannawarra Shire Council for the first time will need to visit one of the Kerang or Cohuna Council offices to make registration arrangements.

A late payment fee of \$38.00 per animal may apply after 11 April, 2019.

GREEN WASTE SERVICE

What do you do with your green waste? Gannawarra Shire Council offers an opt-in Green Waste collection service in the towns of Cohuna, Kerang and Koondrook.

Items that can go in your Green Waste bin include grass clippings; leaves; small prunings and flowers; weeds; and twigs and small branches (no thicker than 15cm or longer than 60cm).
