### RENEWALS DUE 11 APRIL

Dog and cat owners are reminded that animal registration payments need to be made by Monday, 11 April 2021.

Reduced registration fees are applicable for pets aged over 10 years; dogs kept for working stock; animals that are registered with an Applicable Organisation; and animals that are desexed. Additional discounts also apply if the owner currently holds an eligible pension card.
