OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS OPEN MONDAY, 18 NOVEMBER 2019

The Cohuna and Kerang outdoor swimming pools will open for the 2019/20 season at 3pm on Monday, 18 November 2019.

General admission charges at both pools remain at \$4.50 for adults, \$3.50 for children aged four to 17 years and \$3.00 for pensioners. Children under the age of three may enter for free. Family season tickets, which provide season long access to both the Kerang and Cohuna Swimming Pools, as well as Leitchville Swimming Pool, are available for \$180. Activities on offer at both venues - including waterslides,

inflatable pool toys and the Kerang Splash Park – are free to use as part of the entry fee to each pool.

MAJOR COMMUNITY PROJECT FUND

Applications are open for funding from Council's Major Community Project Fund, with \$250,000 allocated in Council's 2019/20 Budget to support infrastructure projects on non-Council owned or controlled land.

Examples of such land may include recreation reserves, sporting facilities, community halls and playgrounds on crown land or land managed by other agencies or community groups.

Applications will be considered for community, sport and recreation infrastructure projects, with funding of between \$10,000 and \$125,000 per project available. Funding preference will be given to projects that have confirmed funding from external grants, or other sources, and/or an inkind contribution.


