FIRE HAZARD CLEARING

Council is undertaking fire hazard inspections throughout the Gannawarra, identifying properties which need to be cleared of fire risks.

Properties deemed to be a high fire risk (e.g. long uncut grass) will be issued with a Fire Prevention Notice instructing the landholder to carry out works to reduce the risk.

You can play your part by reducing fine fuels on your property, including bark, leaves, twigs and long grass.
