Last week my fellow Councillors and I adopted the Gannawarra Shire 2025-2029 Council Plan and Gannawarra Community Vision 2040.

Council conducted extensive consultation earlier this year, speaking with more than 700

residents of all ages to help with the development of these documents.

You, our residents, engaged in good faith discussions, highlighting a strong sense of community and our natural environment as some of the Gannawarra's strengths. However, poor road conditions, rising living costs and access to healthcare and affordable housing were of great concern. The development of these documents considered a variety of sources, not just the Gannawarra community. These include the previous Council Plan, consultants, Councillors, State and Federal Government policies and service delivery partners. A university also provided input.

The result are documents that provide a high-level outline of priorities and policy focus for Council during the next four years. I hope all those who engaged with Council can see their comments and aspirations reflected in them. I encourage all residents to monitor the implementation and interpretation of these plans.
