In preparation for the Victorian Government's e-waste ban to be introduced on 1 July, 2019 two sites in the Gannawarra Shire have been selected to receive upgrades as part of the Victorian government \$15 million commitment to upgrade more than 130 e-waste collection sites across Victoria.

Transfer stations at Kerang and Cohuna

were selected by the Victorian Government to receive upgrades based on their population and accessibility to nearby smaller towns.

The upgrades will mean that all e-waste including any item that has batteries, a plug or cord will be able to be recycled. To help further reduce landfill, Lalbert Transfer Station has received a new recycling trailer while the Quambatook Transfer Station has seen improvements to accommodate waste and recycling.
