

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PETS

Dog and cat owners are reminded to clean up after their pets whilst using public spaces within the Gannawarra Shire.
As part of Council's *Community Amenity Local Law 2023*, dog and cat owners must clean up any excrement from their pets on Council-managed land, and must carry with them litter disposal devices, such as litter bags, when out with their pets.
Refusal to do either of these can result in a fine of \$192.31.

Council-managed animal litter bag dispensers are located at several popular parks and reserves throughout the municipality.
