BEAT THE BITE!

Wetter than average rainfall during winter and early spring and flooding throughout the Avoca, Loddon and Murray river catchments has created ideal breeding conditions for mosquitoes.

Residents can protect themselves from being bitten by limiting outdoor activity when mosquitoes are most active, wearing long, loose fitting clothes, and applying a mosquito repellent containing picaridin or DEET to exposed skin when outdoors.

Removing stagnant water and keeping the area around homes well maintained can reduce mosquito breeding sites. A knockdown fly-spray or surface spray can be effective in reducing adult mosquitoes.
