LIGHTING THE GANNAWARRA

Residents and visitors are benefiting from improved street lighting across the Gannawarra thanks to the recent completion of the Lighting the Regions project.

As part of the project, lightbulbs in 150 streetlights throughout the municipality were replaced with LED varieties, which provide greater illumination whilst reducing Council's carbon footprint.

Council is one of 11 municipalities participating in the Central Victoria Greenhouse Alliance project, which was made possible thanks to Federal Government stimulus funding through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program.
