MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Work continues across the Gannawarra to make the area a great place for residents and visitors. Improvements to the Quambatook Weir and connections between this popular site and the Quambatook township are on track to be completed by early December. As part of these works, a jetty and boat ramp, seating and fire pit have been installed at the Quambatook Weir site. This project also involves developing additional walking tracks between the weir pool and township, and the installation of a pedestrian bridge spanning the Avoca River near the Quambatook township. Meanwhile, The Glasshouse is on track to be open by November. This extension to Kerang's Sir John Gorton Library will enable community groups to meet in a facility that features the latest connectivity technology and for the Gannawarra Library Service to expand its already popular program of events and activities. Both projects would not be possible without the support of the State Government, whose significant contribution has enabled these works to occur.
