COHUNA (10.30am – 12 noon)

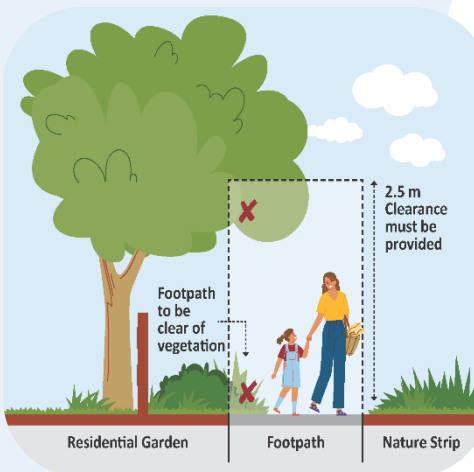
KERANG (4pm – 5.30pm)

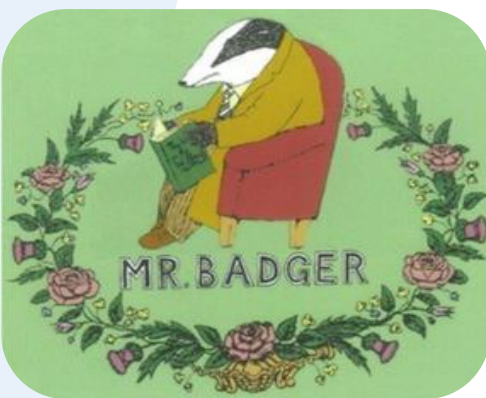
