MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Work continues to improve our urban stormwater drainage network to reduce the repeat of events that residents experience during Christmas Day 2023 and early January 2024. Late last month more than 20 residents took the opportunity to learn how

the development of the Kerang Stormwater Drainage Study is progressing. These discussions with Council staff and Maker ENG representatives enabled residents to view maps highlighting locations where stormwater or drainage-related flooding is prominent and historic data from events that occurred in January 2011 and December 2023.

Meanwhile, future improvements to Kerang's urban stormwater drainage system will benefit from the recent acquisition of a Goulburn-Murray Water drain located between the Loddon River and the Murray Valley Highway.

Council will incorporate the drain into future improvements to Kerang's urban stormwater drainage network, with these works to be guided by the Kerang Stormwater Drainage Study and Gannawarra Urban Stormwater Management Plan.
